I. Call to order

- b. 2008 events schedule: Events scheduled for this year are the Easter Egg Hunt in March, the May garage sale, the September garage sale, the picnic in October, the Halloween event and the train ride with Santa in December as well as the home decorating contest.
- c. 2008 meeting schedule: there should be 4 meetings per year. For this year, Bruce is planning one in March, one in May, one in October and then the last in November for elections.
- d. NCC yard waste ban: DSWA offers services for this as well as some of the trash companies. It was mentioned that "no dumping" signs should be posted in our open spaces.
