Board Meeting Minutes

March 4, 2009

I. Call to order

Bruce Lipphardt called to order the board meeting of the Timber Farms Civic Association at 7:00 p.m. on March 4, 2009 at 139 Woodland Road.

II. Roll call

The following board members were present: Bruce Lipphardt, Bob Oakes and Camille Dinon. Also present were Dave Schneider and John Viola.

III. Open issues

- 1.) Membership update: Membership is only at 40% currently.
- 2.) Break-in on Anthony Drive:
 - a. The owner of the house that was broken into is very upset. The burglars parked in Norwegian Woods and drove out through Norwegian Woods to escape.
 - b. The issue of the existence of the barrier between Timber Farms and Norwegian Woods has been raised. The owner of the home feels that the barrier is a safety issue especially for her since her home is the closest to the barrier. She also feels as though she would not have been robbed if the barrier was not there.
 - c. John Viola gave some background on the barrier and the issues that have been raised including increased traffic through the neighborhood.
 - d. It was mentioned that current maps and 911 information show that there is no barrier and that our two neighborhoods are connected.
 - e. Possible solutions were mentioned including having the maps updated and putting a security camera at the entrance/exit of the neighborhood to capture images of vehicles involved in crimes in the neighborhood.
- 3.) Next General Meeting: plan to allow Mary Pat to speak at the meeting under "New Business".
 - a. If she mentions removing the barricade Bruce can open it up to discussion.
 - b. May also need to have a separate General Meeting to discuss this issue
