Bruce has been tabulating pros and cons. surveys should be out by the end of the year, send back by Feb. 1st. Bruce asked for any comments. Res: length of lane will be changed? Bruce: not in the cards right now. could cause dangerous situation at peak traffic. Bruce: residents have voiced concerns about new drivers using that turn lane with pressure from other drivers. Res: using e-mail instead of regular mail to save on postage? Bruce: security issues with e-mail, not everyone is on our e-mail list. Survey costs about \$200 including postage paid envelope. Res: question about statistics for intersection. seem to be a lot of accidents. Bruce: only 2 crashes involving eastbound turn lanes although there were several near misses including a teenage driver. Bryan: residents feel very passionate about the issue due to the near misses. Res: walk light has not been working, he called into DelDOT, still not fixed. Bryan: e-mailing about that issue right now. Res: asked about set up of light now, green arrow then to green light. don't always get the green arrow.
