

**Timber Farms Civic Association
Combined General Meeting Minutes
October 21, 2015**

Call to order:

- Bruce Lipphardt called the combined meeting to order of the Timber Farms Civic Association and Timber Farms Maintenance Association at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 21, 2015 at the Thurgood Marshall School.

Nominations were accepted by the candidates. Elections will be held at the next general meeting to be held in November.
- New business: A proposal regarding adding a four-way stop sign at the entrance to the new section of the neighborhood (Woodland and Hummock) was presented.
